Day 1

Pick up from your accommodation in Entebbe or Kampala, meet and greet by The Uganda Safari Company Driver/Guide who will transfer you to Entebbe Airport (-/+15 minutes) for a scheduled flight to Kisoro (07h00/08h10). Meet and greet by a lodge representative who will transfer you to Sheba's Camp where you will embark on a boat cruise on Lake Mutanda for about -/+ 2 hours. Kindly note that the boat cruise is weather dependent. After, you will enjoy a lunch at Chameleon Hill Lodge. Later proceed to Clouds Mountain Gorilla Lodge in the southern sector of Bwindi Impenetrable Forest National Park.

In the afternoon go for the Buniga Forest Walk and visit the Batwa Community.

Overnight at Clouds Mountain Gorilla Lodge (Meals + non-premium brand drinks).

Day 2

Full day Gorilla tracking in the Nkuringo/Rushaga area (depending on gorilla permit availability) (Optional)

Overnight at Clouds Mountain Gorilla Lodge (Meals + non-premium brand drinks).

Day 3

After breakfast, transfer by road in a lodge vehicle (shared with other guests) for 2 hours from Clouds Mountain Gorilla Lodge to Kisoro Airstrip to catch a scheduled flight from Kisoro/Entebbe (08h25/11h25). Note that the scheduled flight makes two stops at different airstrips before arriving in Entebbe Airport.

SAFARI PRICE

We try to make our prices as all-inclusive as possible so that our clients do not need to reach for their wallets. Where there are overland sectors, the 4x4 land cruiser and safari guide will be at the clients' exclusive. The guide will accompany clients on all overland sectors, assist with check-in at accommodation and share his knowledge on the flora and fauna of Uganda.

Price Includes:

- Meals as specified in the (hotels in Entebbe are B&B)
- Drinks as stipulated in itinerary
- Accommodation as stipulated in the itinerary
- Water in the vehicle for overland sectors
- Scheduled flights, inclusive of airport taxes where applicable, as specified in the itinerary
NB: Baggage restriction of 15kgs per person (no more) is applicable on all flights in small, soft-sided bags. This includes hand luggage. Extra luggage will incur a charge of \$3 per kg, per sector, to be paid directly to the airline upon check-in.
NB: Certain routings have restrictions on schedules and have minimum numbers: details will be confirmed upon booking
- All ground transportation and transfers as indicated, which are inclusive of fuel
- Activities as stipulated in the itinerary
- Park, ranger guide, conservation fees
- Community bed night fees
- All applicable taxes, administration and banking fees

- Gorilla permits as stipulated in the itinerary:



- Gorilla tracking is subject to availability of permits, which are limited to 8 per Gorilla family per day
- Gorilla permits cannot be held/secured/booked with the Uganda Wildlife Authority or the Rwanda Development Board in advance of payment – they are only secured once physically paid for. We can check availability of permits but we cannot hold them.
- We will invoice for the permits, and as soon as the funds clear in our account, we will go ahead and purchase.
- Gorilla permits are always 100% non-transferable and non-refundable.
- There is a minimum age limit for gorilla tracking of 15 years (no exceptions).
- In Uganda, please be advised that if clients are staying at Clouds Mountain Gorilla Lodge, we shall endeavour to buy Nkuringo Gorilla group permits – the Nkuringo group (encompassing the Bushaho, Nkuringo, Christmas families) tracking start point is close to the Lodge. If at the time of booking, Nkuringo group permits are not available, we shall secure permits from the Rushaga group (encompassing the Busingye, Kahungye, Bweza, Shongi, Mishaya Families) which is a 45 – 60-minute drive from Clouds. There is an additional cost of approximately \$188 (per vehicle) which transfers guests to the tracking start point, waits and returns them to the Lodge.
- All passport and visa fees:
 - **Uganda:** With effect from 01 July 2016, the Government of Uganda has introduced an online visa application system. Guests intending to visit Uganda for tourism-purposes are required to apply and obtain a visa online: <https://visas.immigration.go.ug/>. We have a separate document detailing more information on how-to apply – please advise us if you need this. Single entry tourist visas are available at a cost of \$50), and East African tourist visas (between Uganda | Rwanda | Kenya) are available at a cost of \$100.
 - **Rwanda:** All visa applications for Rwanda are applied via their online visa application system. Guests intending to visit Rwanda for tourism-purposes are required to apply and obtain a visa online: <http://www.migration.gov.rw/>. Single entry tourist visas are available at a cost of \$50. East African tourist visas (between Uganda | Rwanda | Kenya) are available at a cost of \$100.
- All health vaccinations and medications, including, but not limited to:
 - **Yellow Fever vaccinations are currently compulsory for entry into Uganda. All those entering Uganda must be in possession of a valid and original Yellow Fever vaccination card**
- International flights and associated airport departure taxes
- Meals not specified (including lunch and other meal stops between properties on overland sectors)
- Drinks where not stipulated in itinerary
- Items of a personal nature
- Laundry in Kampala / Entebbe



- Gratuities for guides / drivers / hotel staff etc.
- Any extras and additional activities not mentioned in the itinerary
- Charges incurred as a result of delays or cancellations or other inconveniences beyond our control
- Trip cancellation, travel delay or baggage insurance
- All statutory increases beyond our control
